From the Finance Committee The fiscal year of the parish ends on June 30th and it will take a while for the parish business manager to provide a complete report of revenue and expenditures for the 2023/2024 fiscal year. Despite the many challenges of the past fiscal year the Finance Committee is grateful to all those who responded to our financial challenges with a spirit of "sacrifice, hard work, and simplicity."

It was through the hard work and generosity of many that the parish was able to:

- 1. Make all of the payments to St. Pius X/St. Leo School after falling behind in payments during the first half of the fiscal year;
- 2. Fund the renovation of the rectory living quarters (with volunteer help playing a critical role);
- 3. Set aside a fund for needed updates to the Parish Center.

In addition to the many volunteers who worked on and contributed to our parish fundraisers, the parish received bequests and memorial gifts that aided the funding of the various parish ministries.

Challenges lie ahead to terms of meeting the budgetary commitments that are part of the 2024/2025 budget. But we are confident that with Fr. Mark's leadership and our committed parish staff, our parish community will once again respond with a spirit of "sacrifice, hard work, and simplicity."
