Finance Report A regular feature of the weekly parish bulletin has included a report on the current state of finances of the parish. Over the years the precise format of this presentation has changed in an effort to present accurate and timely information. With Fr. Mark's arrival and with his input, the format has been changed to reporting the contributions received by the parish during the preceding week.

Fr. Mark is planning to give an update on parish finances in a letter that will be sent to all parishioners. That update will include a report on the past fiscal year (ending 6/30/24) as well as the change in budgeting for facilities maintenance and upkeep. The Committee is very grateful for Fr. Mark's active leadership and involvement in bringing innovative strategies to the Finance Committee.

September 30th will mark the end of the first quarter of the fiscal year. The months of July and August are typically months in which the weekly contributions decrease. The expenses of the parish, however, do not decrease during this period. We ask for your support in September to make sure the parish can continue to meet its monthly obligations. Please consider using the "Vacation Make-up" in your envelope packet.

Ann's Attic/Parish Garage Sale We would like to extend a thank you to all those who volunteered at our annual Ann's Attic clothing sale and Parish Garage Sale. It does take a lot of hands and hard work. We surpassed previous years with over \$4000 from Ann's Attic and over \$8000 from the garage sale.
