From Health Ministry According to the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), December 1-7 is National Handwashing Awareness AND National Influenza Vaccination Weeks (NIVW). Handwashing: Many diseases, including influenza, can be avoided by washing hands. Influenza (or flu) is a contagious respiratory illness caused by flu viruses. Since flu viruses are constantly changing and protection from vaccination decreases over time, getting a flu vaccine every year is the best way to reduce your risk from flu. A flu vaccine is the only vaccine that protects against flu and, according to the CDC, reduces the risk of flu illness, hospitalization, and death.
